- 3. One Costume Fee of \$100 (Non-Refundable after December 1st)

# Classes

Dream offers a variety of classes from September to June including: Ballet, Pointe, Jazz, Tap, Lyrical, Contemporary, Technique, Musical Theater, Modern, Leaps & Turns, and Hip-Hop. In all classes (except Technique) technique is stressed the first half of the year, while in the second half we concentrate on our recital dance.

## **Awards**

Children should be rewarded for their hard work and dedication. Therefore, all children will receive trophies for their fifth and tenth year of dance.

### **Mid-Year Observation**

Please understand that we generally keep the doors closed while classes are in session.

Opened doors are very distracting especially for our young dancers.

Therefore, in mid-January we invite parents into our DanceMix classes to see all the hard work and accomplishments thus far.

Bring your cameras, video cameras, etc. More information will be given before December.

# **End of Year Recital**

In June, we will hold our 3rd annual recital at Randolph High School, date TBD. The recital gives the children a chance to showcase all of their hard work and dedication displayed throughout the year. We encourage, but do not force, all children to perform in the recital. Our recitals are professionally videotaped and videos are available for purchase.

#### **Costumes**

Every child performing in the recital must purchase a costume. Costume cost is \$100 and is due upon registering. A full reimbursement of the costume payment will be issued if by December 1st your child decides not to participate in the recital. Full payment will not be reimbursed thereafter. Price does not include alterations, tights or accessories.

# School Closings and Vacation Dates

- In the event of inclement weather, please check your emails/the studio Facebook for class cancellations. Dream is allotted 1 Snow Day for each dance day that will NOT be made up. Studio vacation dates are as follows:

# **Class Placements**

Children are placed according to talent, skills, their ability to execute certain steps, prior dance experience and hard work, not necessarily age. Children are placed in classes appropriate to this criteria and are moved to the next level according to this criteria.

\*If a child begins taking a class and needs to be moved to a more or less advanced class, adjustments will be made immediately

\*Ballet is the foundation for all other dance forms. It teaches grace, helps with balance and increases flexibility. It is recommended that all children take a ballet class in addition to their other classes. It is mandatory that any student enrolled in a Competition Lyrical, Jazz or Contemporary class take a ballet and technique class. It is also mandatory that any student enrolled in a Competition Lyrical, Jazz, Modern or Contemporary class take a summer ballet intensive. NO EXCEPTIONS!

## **Studio Policies**

- Tuition is due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month and is non-refundable.
- A \$25 Late Fee must be paid if tuition is paid past the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- After 3 weeks of non-payment, your child will not be permitted to dance.
- There is a \$25 Returned Check Fee. If a check is returned twice, cash payment will only be accepted.
- If you commit to a competition class in September you are committed until June and MUST participate in all rehearsals and competitions. Registration fee, Competition fees and Costume fees are non-refundable.



#### **Dream Classes:**

#### **Ballet**

The backbone of all dance genres, ballet is a classical form of dance that focuses on alignment, posture, technique and musicality. Class will consist of but not be limited to barre work, adagio, allegro, across the floor and reverence. This is MANDATORY requirement for any student competing in Jazz, Lyrical, or Modern. It is HIGHLY recommended that all dancers take ballet class in addition to any other genre they wish to study.

DRESS CODE: pink ballet tights & leotard with hair in bun. No exceptions.

SHOES: pink ballet shoes either canvas split sole or leather split sole

#### **Teeny Boppers**

For children ages 2-3

A great class for little ones who need to move and groove! 45 minute class that introduces the very basics in movement, balance, coordination and sensory skills. Interactive games are incorporated including parachute play, balance games, obstacle courses, etc. Teeny dancers will perform in the recital and do NOT need to be potty trained.

DRESS CODE: leotard, tights, pink ballet shoes

#### **DanceMix**

For children ages 3-5

A fun and engaging introduction to dance! Each class is an hour long and will include either a half an hour of ballet and half an hour of tap OR half jazz and half hip hop! This will include across the floor, center work and ALWAYS finish with a fun and engaging game. Children will only perform one genre in the recital. The teacher will pick which genre based on how the class develops.

DRESS CODE: leotard & tights with pink ballet shoes & black tap shoes, OR comfortable clothing with jazz shoes and black hip hop shoes

#### Hip Hop

An upbeat and high energy class! This dance form is front and center in our daily lives. Come get funky with exciting and current choreography set to current hip hop music.

DRESS CODE: comfy clothes

SHOES: sneakers



#### **Musical Theater**

Lights, camera, action! Musical theater is perfect for those who want to learn the art of acting mixed with dancing! Students are able to express themselves using facial expressions and emotion! This class will consist of broadway jazz style movement and music from popular musicals, plays, and movies!

DRESS CODE: comfortable clothing

SHOES: decided by instructor

#### Jazz

Sassy and upbeat! Fun and energizing! Jazz focuses on technical skills such as pirouettes, jetes, and flexibility. Jazz mixes hip hop, broadway and contemporary moves that has captured audiences attention for years!

DRESS CODE: tank top/crop top/sports bra & shorts/tights/leggings

SHOES: decided by instructor

#### Lyrical

Focusing on technical skills such as leaps, pirouettes and battements with the incorporation of emotion and learning to express oneself through dance and music. Lyrical will incorporate some of today's contemporary style with fluidity, uniqueness, and beauty. Ballet is highly recommended to take while taking lyrical.

DRESS CODE: tank top/leotard/crop top/sports bra & shorts/tights/leggings

SHOES: turners

#### Tap

Focusing on musicality and rhythm, the dancer learns to express themselves through their feet and through sound.

DRESS CODE: no baggy clothes please SHOES: black full sole Bloch Tap shoes

#### **Technique**

Strength and conditioning to build strong dancers! Flexibility will be a main focus. Technique is super important in every style of dance! This class is REQUIRED for any dancer competing in jazz, lyrical or modern.

DRESS CODE: leotard/tank top/crop top/sports bra & shorts/leggings/tights

SHOES: barefeet or turners



#### **Leaps and Turns**

A fun class consisting of strictly leaps and turns! Learn the proper techniques to achieve high beautiful leaps as well as perfecting pirouettes!

DRESS CODE: tank top/leotard/crop top/sports bra & shorts/leggings/tights

SHOES: turners

#### Acro

Come learn the basics of gymnastics infused with dance! We offer beginner and advanced level classes for those interested in working on their gymnastics skill!

#### **Cheer Funk**

A new style to Dream where dancers will learn pom and dance team moves! This style incorporates hip hop and jazz with sharp and energetic movements!

DRESS CODE: comfortable clothing

#### Assumption of Risk, Release of Liability, Medical Emergencies

As the legal parent or guardian, I hereby release and hold harmless Dream Dance Academy, its owners, agents, servants and employees from and against any and all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related to any loss, misadventure, harm, cost, damage, or injury, including death, that may arise from or relate to my child's and/or the participant's participation in Dream Dance Academy classes and other activities while in or upon the premises or any premises under the control and/or supervision of Dream Dance Academy, their owners and operators, or while en route to or from any of such premises. I certify that my child is in good health and proper physical condition to take part in dance activities. I understand that participation in classes involves physical movement and, therefore, there are certain risks inherent in the art of dancing. I agree to provide medical insurance for my child and family. If my emergency contact cannot be reached, I give permission to the staff of Dream Dance Academy to render aid or to act on my behalf to obtain emergency medical treatment for the above named student for any illness or injury that may occur while attending classes, rehearsal, performances, or on the premises.

Payment and Other Policies

- Tuition is payable under one of the following payment plans and due dates:
- i. 1 Payment, due upon registration;
- ii. 10 Payments due as follows: 1st at registration; next 9 on the 10th of each month, starting 10/10/21, ending 6/10/22
- If my payment for any charge is overdue by four (4) days or more, I hereby authorize Dream to charge my credit/debit card (that I have provided below) for the full amount due including any past due fees and charges.



- All checks are payable to "Dream Dance" and a service fee of \$25.00 will be charged for every bounced check. A late fee of \$25.00 per month for all missed payments will be assessed and payable regardless of the reason.
- I understand that failure to pay tuition, late fees, or any other charges may result in termination of my child's participation in their classes and any other Dream Dance Academy activities until such a point that my account is made current.
- I understand that all recital costume charges are due on or before December 1, 2021 and that my child's participation in the annual recital is subject to my payment in full of all amounts due.
- I understand that if I decide to drop out of a class, I must notify the Dream Dance Academy business manager in writing by the 5th of the preceding month in which my student is dropping to avoid being charged for the month (for example, you must notify the office on or before the 5th of October to avoid being charged for November).
- I understand that (a) all registration fees are non-refundable, (b) Dream Dance Academy does NOT issue refunds for any reason, including missed classes due to illness, vacation, religious observance, inclement weather studio closings, or withdrawal, and (c) any missed classes may be made up in a similar class during the same school year, subject to availability.
- I understand and agree to adhere to the following: (i) Dream Dance Academy policies, including those described on the Dream website; and (ii) if my child is a Dream Dance Competition Team member, the responsibilities described in the Dream Dance Competition Team Agreement.
